

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CS REGULATIONS

Ref:	C S Regulations 11-006
Re:	CS Regulations A 20.2 Notice – Last Working Day
Proposal:	To permit an Accounting Officer to determine the date of resignation if the civil servant is disadvantaged when the resignation takes place on a Friday. For example when a civil servant commences a new appointment with an IOM Government employing authority.
Existing Regs:	20.2 LAST WORKING DAY Where a civil servant resigns voluntarily, the period of notice may expire only on the last working day of a week i.e. a Friday or the last working day of the week if a bank/public holidays fall at the end of the week.
Proposed Amendment:	20.2 LAST DAY OF SERVICE Where a civil servant resigns voluntarily, the period of notice may expire <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. only on the last working day of a week i.e. a Friday; or 2. on the last working day of the week if a bank/public holiday falls at the end of the week; or 3. on a day agreed with the Accounting Officer, who may delegate this responsibility via an appropriate formal delegation of authority.
