Re: Equalised Pay

Further to our telephone conversation in respect of arrangements in relation to the implementation of equalised pay for school meals staff I am pleased to advise you of the following:-

Concern has been expressed of how changes in pay rates will be addressed. I can confirm that any changes will be dealt with exactly as at present, being calculated and paid to employees as soon as practicable after notification is issued. As you are aware the main reason for employees requesting equalisation of pay is due to the fluctuation in monthly payments. I have enclosed a payment of wages calendar which illustrates quite clearly how these variations come about. Also enclosed is an example of the manner in which each employees pay entitlement is to be calculated to ensure that the correct annual payment divided equally for each month is to be made. You will note that all details of relevance to the employees pay is contained on the sheet including holiday entitlement which may, depending on appointment date, change within the pay year.

I hope the foregoing addresses all concerns which may have arisen in connection with the introduction of equalised pay. However, I would be very pleased to respond to any further queries surrounding this issue if requested.
