Proposal:	To amend an incorrect reference within the first paragraph which relates to On Call Allowance Rates at Annex C2 (i). Annex C2 (i) no longer exists and has been renamed Annex C2

On-Call Allowances</p> <p><i>Last updated 31 May 2012 - Amendment No <u>12-009</u></i></p> <p><i><u>Corporate Leadership Group – Terms and Conditions Exclusions</u></i></p> <p>Provided their pay does not already include an element for on-call commitments, civil servants who are eligible to claim overtime may claim on-call allowances at the rates set out in Annex C2(i) if they satisfy the following conditions: -</p> <p>a) On-Call - Home Payable to a civil servant who has a specific rostered commitment to remain continuously and immediately available for recall to duty, at home, outside their normal conditioned hours.</p> <p>b) On-Call - Radio Pager or Mobile Telephone Payable to a civil servant who has a specific rostered commitment to remain continuously and immediately available for recall to duty by means of a radio pager or mobile telephone outside their normal conditioned hours.
