

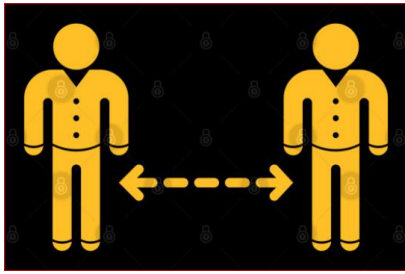

During these difficult times the safety and wellbeing of our frontline medical and support staff is vital to reduce the potential impact on all of our lives in the future.

We can all play our part by adhering to the following strict but simple measures:

- Wash your hands, before you leave your house, when you arrive at work, regularly and thoroughly throughout the day, with soap and water for at least 20 seconds following the correct procedure
- Do not touch your face with your hands.
- Follow safe social distancing guidelines – do not overcrowd your aisles and store passageways.
- Know where it is safe to leave supplies without getting too close to people or unauthorised areas.
- Follow safe lifting techniques, safe ladder techniques,
- Do not operate equipment unless you have been trained to operate it safely.
- Wipe clean trolley/equipment handles after use
- Wash your hands when you arrive home
