Your holiday balance explained (Salaried Dentist)

The example below is an individual who has 27 days annual leave plus an additional 5 days carried forward for the 2020/2021 annual leave year.

Note: to convert your holiday entitlement into days simply divide the hours figure by your standard working day e.g. 7.5.

Entitlement example:
This is your annual leave entitlement which includes:

- Your annual leave entitlement e.g. 27 days (202.5 hours)
 - Any annual leave carried forward to this leave year e.g. 5 days (37.5 hours)
 - 10 bank holidays (75 hours)
- = 315 hours (42 days in total)**
