Re:	Article 17 – Annual Holidays – Reckonable Service	
Proposal:	To update the MOA to meet the statutory requirements regarding the accrual of annual leave during periods of sickness as set out in the Annual Leave Regulations 2007.	

Existing Regulation:

Reckonable service

- 15. Annual leave will not be accrued during absences from work for the following reasons:
 - a. absences on unpaid special leave or unpaid sick leave and
 - b. continuous absence on sick leave prior to premature retirement on the grounds of ill health

However (a) does not break continuous service for the purpose of qualifying for a higher leave allowance.

Proposed Regulation:

Reckonable service

- 15. Contractual Aannual leave will not be accrued during absences from work for the following reasons:
 - a. absences on unpaid special leave, or unpaid sick leave, additional maternity leave, additional adoption leave or parental leave and
 - b. continuous absence on sick leave prior to premature retirement on the grounds of ill health.

However (a) does not break continuous service for the purpose of qualifying for a higher leave allowance.

Consideration should be given to any entitlement to Statutory Leave (4 weeks' paid leave each year) which may be applicable.
