

What is a near miss?

A near miss is an unplanned event that did not result in any injury, illness, or damage, but had the potential to do so.

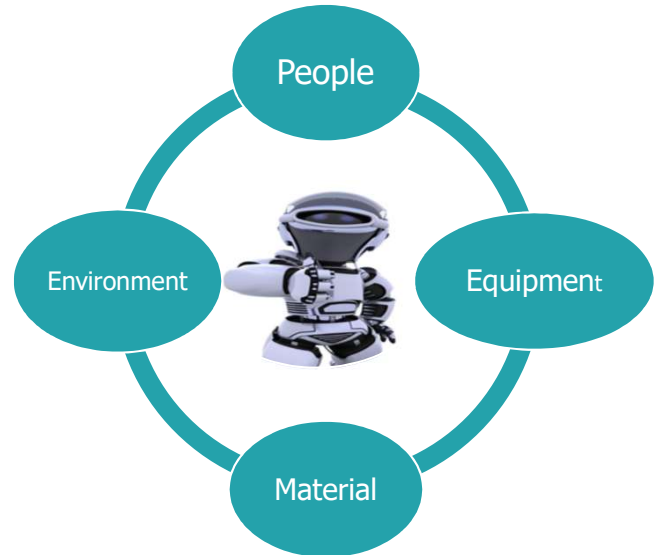
When the sequence of events that could lead to an accident is interrupted by chance, it prevents any harm or loss from taking place.

Why report near misses and safety concerns??

It is far better to be reporting and learning from near misses, minor incident and hazards, where there is little or no loss, than to be reporting actual serious losses. For every 600 near misses there are 30 minors, 10 serious and 1 fatal, if we don't report them we cannot try to prevent that 1 fatal, who will it be?



Meet **PEME** Our **SAFETY BOT**, he helps us learn about the hazards that are present in our working area - **People Equipment Material and Environment** – if we control these through Risk Assessment and reporting when things don't go to plan we can keep everyone safe
